

A New Look at the Older Media

Printed Instructional Materials

SARA KRENTZMAN SRYGLEY

LIBRARY COLLECTIONS planned today for modern secondary schools are quite different from those of the 1920's and 1930's. While they differ in including a wider variety of educational media, with projected and recorded materials now considered standard fare, they differ also in the nature and size of their collections of printed materials and the services related to them.

Current emphasis on innovation in education is usually accompanied by recognition of the importance of providing materials adequate in number and in quality for the types of teaching and learning experiences planned. More often than not, there is defensible concern for recognition of the potential of the newer communication media and their best uses. There is not always the same degree of concern for the most effective use of the older media—books, periodicals, pamphlets, brochures, abstracts, monographs, etc. Nor is there always an understanding of the related-

ness of printed and audio-visual media, requiring in many situations a cross-media approach for best results in teaching.

Identification of the best materials for educational purposes, ample provision of them in schools, and proper use of them in teaching constitute a major educational challenge today. The need for teachers to become more knowledgeable about the printed resources available and short-cuts to locating them is the result of two major developments. First, increasing awareness of the individual differences in learners and the implications of these differences for both school organization and teaching methods requires schools to make serious efforts to provide appropri-
